Mayor Giles called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m.

PUBLIC COMMENT-PERSONAL COMMUNICATION-CORRESPONDENCE:

There were no comments from the public, and no personal communication or correspondence.

BUSINESS IMPACT DETERMINATION:

After review and consideration of the probable effect that each agenda item for this meeting could have on a "business" as defined by statute, Councilman Murphy moved to make a finding that no item on this meeting agenda appears to impose a direct and significant economic burden on a business or directly restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a business.

Motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARING / FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019 TENTATIVE BUDGET-FINAL BUDGET:

Mayor Giles noted no members of the public were present. No comments were made.

Mayor Giles said a 5% insurance premium increase was included in the tentative budget and although liability insurance premiums went up by 12%, other insurance premiums decreased, and the overall insurance premium increase came to about 4.6%. The workers compensation modification factor decreased. A 10% increase in health insurance premium costs was included in the budget, however, health insurance premium rates decreased by 3%. Giles recommended leaving the health insurance item in the budget as proposed. The budget also contains a 25 cents per hour increase in the wages of all City employees, to be effective July 1, 2018. Giles recommended the tentative budget as proposed and explained be adopted as the final budget.

Councilman Donaldson moved that the City of Lovelock 2018-2019 tentative budget as explained be adopted as the fiscal year 2018-2019 final budget for submittal to the Department of Taxation.

Motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

There were no comments from the public.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:15 p.m. until the next scheduled City Council meeting on June 5, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.
