An unmodified opinion was issued for the financial statements, which is the highest level of assurance for government auditing standards. General Fund revenues were approximately \$1 million and expenditures were \$982,000. There were no potential violations of statue or administrative code. No single audit was required for the City as they did not expend more than \$750,000 in federal awards.
