FY 2020-2021 GENERAL FUND BUDGET AUGMENT:

Mayor Giles explained that \$17,608 in unanticipated revenue was received from the Lovelock Indian Colony as a donation from their dispensary funds and the augment to the General Fund must be approved by the governing body. The funds will be used for the City Hall flag poles.

Council member Reynolds moved to approve the \$17,608 augment to the revenue of the FY 2020-2021 General Fund budget as explained.
